School Choice and SGO Scholarships for next year. The Indiana School Choice and SGO Programs assisted 83 Our Lady students this year with over \$270,000 toward tuition and fees. You will need to supply the first page of your 2017 Tax return and proof of child support and other income that you may have received.
