We are almost finished with **ISTEP+ testing** for the year. Friday is the last day of classroom testing, and next week we will finish with individual make-up tests. **Fourth Quarter Progress Reports** will be posted on Thursday, May 3, as we head into the final weeks of school.

Next Wednesday, May 2, we will celebrate **May Crowning** following the All-School Mass at 8:00 AM. All students will be in their Sunday best as we honor Mary, the Holy Mother of God. We look to her for help and follow her example of how to live as we strive to imitate her faith, her obedience and her love. Second grader, Eva Burden, has the privilege of crowning Mary in the culmination of the ceremony.

**Dress code for May 2:** Ladies should wear dresses or skirts and gentlemen slacks and dress shirts. Ties are permitted. No jeans, sweat pants, baggy pants or shorts. Students are not allowed to wear strappy tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops or any type of shirt which displays inappropriate language or scenes. Girls may wear sandals but should bring tennis shoes for recess. Eighth graders wear their graduation attire and will have a picture taken after the Crowning Ceremony. Students may change into their uniform clothes after May Crowning if they wish.
