Successful School Year To have a smooth year, we have important news to share at the start. Please be sure at least one parent of the student is at the required meetings.

Parents of middle school students in Gr. 5-8 will meet at Wagner Hall on Mon., July 31, for the Middle School Parent Forum. We will begin with a meeting at 6:00 PM and conclude in the classrooms by 7:45 PM. Parents will get a chance to meet all faculty and administrators, learn many details regarding middle school dynamics, discipline, dress code, homework and support. Then, parents will have 3 fifteen minute sessions to see their child's homeroom teacher, the other grade level teacher and then 15 min. of Open House time to see Special Area teachers, walk the halls, see classrooms and locker areas. Jupiter passwords, folders of specific procedures and more will be dispersed. You will have an opportunity to support our middle school programming by taking a coupon and returning a \$5 or \$10 gift card for recess items, Special classes, or to help with House activities and projects.
