Guitar Club

Dear Parents,

Hello! My name is Jeremy Sebolt and I have been substitute teaching at Our Lady during this school year. As a lifelong lover of music and guitarist for the Rumors, I know the joy, discipline, and countless benefits of learning to play an instrument.

I would like to initiate a guitar club at Our Lady of Perpetual Help at the start of April. The guitar club will be for students 9 years or older. It will run for 4 weeks and will meet every Monday. Sessions are on April 2, 9, 16 and 23. If there is a large number of students that would like to participate, I would be willing to have the club meet every Monday and Tuesday. The club will meet for 45 minutes each session from 3:00-3:45 PM and will cover the following topics:

- Introduction to the guitar
- How to hold and strum a guitar
- The correct vocabulary and terms surrounding the guitar
- Basic beginners chord structures
- And more depending on the advancement of the class

The club will cost \$60.00 for each child for the 4 weekly meetings. The maximum student capacity will be seven (7) students. Again, if there is a bigger demand, the club could meet two different days to allow fourteen (14) students the chance to be in the club. Students will not need their own guitar as they will be provided for them. I also have items for the students to take home with them to practice on so the parents are not required to buy a guitar.

I do think this will be a fun and inexpensive start to learning an instrument that will carry on for the kids throughout their lives. Please email with your interest or questions.
