Spring Break with its surprising winter wonderland of snow seems a distant memory as we bound into the last quarter of the school year. April brings Easter, Main Event, Book Fair, Middle School Slide, Spring Pictures, ISTEP+ Part 2 for grades 3-8 and First Communion and Retreat for second graders.

**Good Friday** We invite families to join us for our Good Friday Service in the gym at 8:30 AM as eighth graders reenact each station of Jesus' Crucifixion through Shadow Stations. We continue the day in silence and reverence in remembrance of the most precious sacrifice Jesus made to show us his love and our salvation. **School dismissal will be at 2:00 PM with *no Aftercare*; ALL students need to be picked up by 2:00 PM on Friday, March 30.** The Parish Good Friday Service begins at 3:00 PM, and Parish Stations of the Cross will be at 7:00 PM on Good Friday.

**Morning Drop Off.** As always, please be mindful of the safety of our children as you drop off students in the morning.
