**ISTEP+ Part 2 Statewide Testing.** Students in grades 3-8 begin ISTEP+ Part 2 testing next week. Grades 3, 5, and 6 test the week of April 16, and grades 4, 7, and 8 test the week of April 23. Please be sure students arrive at school on time, well-rested with a good breakfast and snack. Please do not make appointments during school as we continue this statewide assessment. The test consists of 3 sections in mathematics and 3 sections in English/language arts. Students in grades 4 and 6 also take 2 additional sections in science, and students in grades 5 and 7 take 2 additional sections in social studies. Go Crusaders!
